## Health Practitioners Competence Assurance Act 2003

### Osteopathic Council (Fees) Notice 2010

Pursuant to Part 6, section 130(1) of the Health Practitioners Competence Assurance Act 2003 (“HPCA Act”), the following notice is given.

#### Notice

- 1. Title and commencement**—(1) This notice may be cited as the Osteopathic (Fees) Notice 2010.  
(2) This notice, to gazette changed practising certificate fees, comes into force on **1 April 2010**.
- 2. Fees**—The Osteopathic Council sets the following fees, payable to the council, specified in the attached Schedule.
- 3. Tax**—The fees are inclusive of goods and services tax.
- 4. Revocation**—This notice revokes all previous Osteopathic Council (Fees) Notices.
